Cats within a breed/division will be benched together and placed throughout the show hall alphabetically by breed name (all Persians will be benched as a group under the heading of "Persian"). If you are exhibiting more than one breed/division, please specify one breed/division for benching purposes. Rabies vaccination required in New York (rabies vet certification required). STARTING TIMES. The show hall will be open at 7:00AM for checkin. All cats must be benched by 8:30AM or they will be marked absent. Judging will begin PROMPTLY at 9:00AM. All entries must remain in the show hall until 6:00PM Saturday and 5:00PM Sunday unless permission is

received from show management.

CFA-IAMS Cat Championship is held under the auspices of the Cat Fanciers' Association. CFA show rules will be enforced. A copy of the rules is available for \$5.00 from CFA, PO Box 1005, Manasquan, NJ 08736. The show management has the right to add judges not named in the show announcement to judge non-championship and non-premiership classes. All championship, premiership, and registered kittens will be scored for CFA National and Regional awards.

- ENTRIES CONFIRMATION. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor, not the entry clerk, to confirm a fax or email entry was received. The show committee is not responsible for faxed or emailed entries not received due to communication errors.
- BEST OF BREED/DIVISION & BEST OF THE BEST. Each of the 6 judges will select their one best of breed/division, regardless of competition level. Provisional and Miscellaneous breeds are not eligible. The results will will be compiled and the cat with the highest ranking within each breed/division will move on to participate in the Best of the Best competition. The Best of the Best judge will handle and judge each of the breed/division participants to determine this year's CFA-IAMS Cat Championship Best of the Best.
- EXHIBITOR SET-UP/CHECK-IN. Exhibitor set-up and check-in will begin at 7:00AM on Saturday, October 14. No one will be allowed in the show hall until that time. Enter Madison Square Garden on 8th Avenue corner, the Employee Entrance.
- SUNDAY DEPARTURE. In making your travel plans for Sunday, the show management asks you to please keep in mind cats will not be released from the show hall until 5:00PM. No cat may leave the show hall until that time without permission from the Show Manager.
- Benching. Cats within a breed/division will be benched together and placed throughout the show hall alphabetically by breed name (all Persians will be benched as a group under the heading "Persian"). If you are exhibiting in more than one breed/division, please specify one breed/division for benching purposes. Cage sizes: 21" x 22" x 22" for single cage; 21" x 22" x 45" for double cage.

Exhibitors with kittens "for sale" must have at least one cat entered in the show for competition. **Kitten Sales Passes** are \$25.00 each per kitten and available at the show at the CFA booth. Limit 3 per day. Kitten sales passes can be purchased at show.

This will be a non-vetted show, however, it is strongly

advised that all cats/kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry, by a licensed veterinarian, against feline enteritis, feline rhinotracheitis and calici viruses and that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV. New York state law requires a rabies vaccine and PROOF OF RABIES VACCINATION MAY BE CHECKED (rabies vet certification required.)

ALL claws on each entry must be clipped prior to benching. Any cat or kitten from a house or cattery where there has been feline distemper (panleukopenia) within 21 days prior to the opening date of a show is ineligible for entry, and, should entry have been made prior to the onset of any such condition, such entry is ineligible for admission into the show room. Only cats which appear healthy, without evidence of fleas, ear mites, or any contagious or infectious illness, are eligible for admission into the show room. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to refrain from bringing an unhealthy cat or kitten into the show hall. Failure to observe this rule will be grounds for disciplinary action.

- BENCHING REQUEST. You may request to be benched next to only one other exhibitor within the benching area of your primary breed. If you specify an agent, that will be your only benching request. Furthermore, the agent must be showing the same breed as the cat being agented. Handicapped benching requests will be accommodated whenever possible, at no extra charge to the exhibitor.
- **SUPPLIES.** Litter will be provided at the show. Please bring your own litter pan, cat food and food & water bowl.
- Foop. No people food or beverages of any type may be brought into the show hall. Concessionaire services will be providing food and beverages.
- CONDITIONS. The show hall is climate controlled (heated and/or air conditioned depending on the weather) and wheelchair accessible. No smoking is permitted in the show hall. Chairs will be provided in benching and judging areas.
- COPYRIGHT. Each entrant agrees that CFA and P&G and only CFA and P&G shall have the right to make commercial use of the name of the Event, any results of the Event, the name of any winning cat or cat owner, still or video pictures taken during the Event or before or after the Event at the site of the Event, if such pictures could create the impression that they were taken during this Event.
