SCORING: All kittens, championship, and premiership entries will be scored for All Canadian and Regional Awards. Household Pets will be scored for Regional Awards.

Show Hours: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm both days. Check in from 7:30 to 8:30 am. Late exhibitors must personally inform all ring clerks of changes.

There will be no veterinary check up prior to the show. Vaccination certificates of all cats present must be up-to-date. All cats or kittens for sale MUST have vaccination record and must be CCA litter registered. Documentation could be requested by the show manager.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Canadian Cat Association sanctions this show and all its rules and regulations shall be maintained. A copy of the Show Rules may be obtained (\$9.00) from The Canadian Cat Association, 289 Rutherford Rd., Suite 18, Brampton, ON

L6N 3R9. No liability shall attain to the club conducting or sponsoring a show in the event of a loss or damage to a cat or container. This applies to the Show Committee or to any individual member of the club. Exhibitors are responsible for a correct description of their entries and must abide by their own errors. Cats wrongfully entered in a cat show cannot receive prizes in these classes except at the discretion of the Show Committee when an error is the exhibitors. Hotel information and directions to the show hall will accompany confirmation of entry.

No cat may be withdrawn or entry fees withheld after the closing date of the show.

Failure of payment for entries disqualifies the exhibitor and their cats from future sanctioned shows until all debts are paid to the club(s) involved. The club reserves the right to substitute judges.

LISTED ENTRIES: All cats entered in Championship, Premiership or kitten classes must be registered with the Canadian Cat Association with the exception of listed entries. Kittens may be entered with a CCA litter registration number. Listed entries must have a CCA listing number in order to be entered. A listing number

must be obtained from the CCA office by sending \$10.60 along with the name of the cat, registration number from another registry,

the name of the host club and the date of the show to be entered. Either by E-mail or mail.

The entry must be registered within 60 days of the show to retain points achieved during the listed show. The show entry form and entry fee must be sent to the entry clerk who will hold it until notified by CCA with the listing number at which time the entry will be processed provided that entries have not closed. Please note that each listing fee is only applicable for one show weekend.

HOUSEHOLD PETS: Must be 4 months of age or older. Cats 8 months or older must be neutered or spayed. Household pets will be judged in all rings. No de-clawed entries allowed.

KITTENS FOR SALE: Kittens must be 3 months of age or older to be in the show hall. Owners must have CCA litter registration on hand to verify age of kittens for sale if requested.

NON-VETTED SHOW: Entries are expected to have current vaccinations and to be free from fleas, ear mites, fungus and disease. (Art 7, Sec 1 & 2). All

claws, front and back, must be clipped prior to benching. Any cat that is found to be ill will be removed from the show hall along with any cats they may have traveled with.

FOOD & LITTER: The club will provide litter. Please bring: your own cat food and dishes and a litter pan for your cat.

Breakfast, parking, extra people and the cats are included. \$135.00, until September 12th. Rooms are large for sharing. The occupant – NOT the club – is responsible for any damage to their hotel room.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: All entries must check-in with the Entry Clerk between 7:30am – 8:30am each day of the show. Judging will commence at 9:00am SHARP each day. Show hours are

Saturday 9am – 5pm and Sunday 9am – 5pm. Early departures MUST have permission to leave from the Show Manager in order not to forfeit any wins. Show hall directions and hotel accommodations will be sent out with confirmation of entries.

NOVICE EXHIBITORS: For your protection, all cats should be brought to the show hall in a carrier. Be sure to bath and groom your cat a day or two prior to the show, so that you are able to present it in the best possible condition. Be sure to bring grooming aids, litter pan, food dishes and cage curtains. Single cage size is approximately 22" x 22" x 22". Curtains can consist of decorated boards, bath towels or other material plus a mat, towel or other soft material for the cage floor. If you are a novice exhibitor please indicate this on your entry form so the club can provide you with extra assistance.

Friday, October 24th at the Show Hall, Club members will be on hand to help new exhibitors set up their show cages and host a practice judging ring for all those interested. Show preparation & grooming clinics can be arranged by demand.
