Chickadee Cat Club's ACFA Cat Show – June 19 & 20, 2010 – General Information



Closing Date: Entries must be RECEIVED BY Friday, June 11, 2010. This date is FIRM.

Make cheques/money orders payable to "Chickadee Cat Club". NSF cheques will be charged \$35.00.

A MAXIMUM of 200 Entries are allowed.

<u>Check-In:</u> 7:30 – 8:30 am. Judging will start at 9 a.m. Anyone not checked in by 8:30 am will be marked absent. ** NOTE: Please bring a copy of your Entry Forms and Confirmation (in case they are required for verification of entries).

<u>Show Hall:</u> Canteen services on site. Vendors will be on site. The show hall is partially climate controlled and fully wheelchair accessible. There is no smoking allowed in the show hall.

<u>Benching:</u> No cats/kittens are allowed to be kept under the show bench or under grooming table in carriers (except while setting up/tearing down). Benching kennels supplied by the show are wire, sizes are 22"x22"x26"for a single (double divided) and 22"x22"x54" for double. Novice exhibitors, bring kennel curtains (coverings for the top, sides and bottom of the kennel). You can request to be benched beside another exhibitor. No change of benching assignments will be made without permission of show management. No cats/kittens may be kept in the show hall overnight. Cats must remain in the show hall during advertised show hours unless written permission is received by show management.

Supplies: Litter is provided; please bring your own litter pan, food & water, and dishes for your felines.

<u>Health:</u> This is a non-vetted show – no veterinary inspection will be required prior to benching. It is necessary that all cats be inoculated at least 30 days in advance of the show for Rhinotracheitis (Feline Herpes Virus), Calici, and Panleucopenia (Enteritis). Proof may be requested, so kindly bring your cats' inoculation records. Exhibitors traveling from the US are reminded that Canada Customs requires that all cats over 3 months of age must have proof of a Rabies vaccination at least 30 days but not more than 365 days prior to entry into Canada. Entries must be free of fleas, ear mites and fungus. Pregnant/lactating queens are not permitted in competition. Declawed cats are permitted, as are clear nail caps. All claws must be clipped prior to showing. If this is not done, it will be performed at a charge of \$8.00 per cat.

<u>Kittens:</u> No kittens under the age of 4 months will be allowed in the show hall. Kittens in the show must have been born between October 19th, 2009 and February 19th, 2010 to be show on Saturday, the 20th to be shown on Sunday only.

<u>Household Pets:</u> All Household Pets over the age of 8 months **MUST BE ALTERED** to be recorded in ACFA or shown. Kittens shown in Household Pet class may be altered or unaltered.

<u>Cat & Kitten Sales:</u> Sales cages are available only to registered breeders who are also exhibiting cats or kittens at this show. Cats and kittens for sale must have proof of Litter or Individual Registration. For minimum age, see "Kittens", above.

<u>ACFA Registration:</u> A cat may be entered in Championship with the Registration # pending. Breeds that **MUST HAVE A REGISTRATION #** to be shown are **Bengal, Korat, Pixie Bob, and Singapura, and all NBC (New Breed or Color) class cats**.

<u>Listing Fee:</u> You may enter a cat in Championship that is not ACFA Registered by paying a Listing Fee (see Entry Summary Form). A registration number must be provided for all Championship entries by the morning of the show or you will be charged the Listing Fee. Championship Cats and Alters can be shown only once without a registration number. This does not apply to Kittens or Household Pets. <u>Awards:</u> Rosettes will be awarded in all Rings according to ACFA Show Rules. Cats must be present to collect all Final awards unless prior permission is received from the Show Manager. ACFA registered/recorded cats will be scored for ACFA Regional and Inter-American awards.

<u>Back-to-Back Show Transfers</u>: Transfers to a higher class (Champion \$7 US or Grand Champion \$12 US) for Sunday's show due to wins on Saturday's show will be accepted by the Master Clerk during the show on Saturday and prior to judging on Sunday. Payment must be included. Bring information from wins at prior shows if applicable. No transfers will be accepted on Sunday after judging begins.

<u>Liability:</u> Although Chickadee Cat Club takes every possible care, the Club, the Show Management, or The American Cat Fanciers Association, Inc. cannot be held liable for loss, damage, injury, or accidents to cats, people, or property. Chickadee Cat Club reserves the right to refuse entry, or remove any persons or animal from show hall for any reason deemed in the best interest of the show. Entry fees will not be refunded. Adults will be held responsible for the proper behaviour of children accompanying them.

<u>Show Rules:</u> This show is run according to the rules of the American Cat Fanciers Association (ACFA). A copy is available for \$7.00 from ACFA, PO Box 1949, Nixa, MO 65714-1949, or on-line at www.acfacat.com/acfa_rules.htm *It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to know the show rules.
