Children are always welcome to show their favorite cat or kitten. Enter your special lap companion and come join the fun!

All cats should be brought into the facility in pet carriers.

Show Rules: Household Pet Competition is open to cats four months old and older. All cats should be bathed, with claws clipped prior to coming to the show. Cats who are eight months or older must be spayed or neutered. All cats should be free of fleas, fungus, ear mites and all contagious diseases and should be current on all their vaccinations. Declawed cats and kittens are not eligible for Household Pet Competition but may be entered in the Feline Agility Competition. Cats of wild ancestry are not allowed for either competition. Any entry with signs of illness, fleas, fungus or ear mites will be asked to leave the show hall.

General Information for Household Pets: Clay litter will be provided. Please bring litter pan, food & water bowls and cat food. Benching cages are approximately 22"x22"x22". Cage curtains are required to cover the sides, top & bottom of cage. Large towels, sheets or fabric with clips or safety pins to secure them to the cage and a throw rug for the bottom make good first time cage curtains. Please contact entry clerk if you have any questions. Registration required for Household Pet Competition. Please submit your cat's information and fees by September 24. Cats for Agility only may pre-register or may register at the show. Agility fee covers one practice run and one timed run.

All registered Household Pet entries must be checked in before judging begins. Show check-in will be Saturday, September 29, between 8:30am & 9:30am. If this is your first time showing your pet, please let us know and a club member will be available to help you get started.
