Show Hall: The show hall is well air-conditioned and wheelchair accessible. No cats may remain in the show hall over night. No smoking is permitted in the show hall. Directions will be sent with confirmation. **There is NO concession stand; feel free to bring your coolers. We will have a lunch break.** Reasonable care will be taken to safeguard the property of exhibitors. The show management and the Jaycee's management will not be held responsible for any loss or damages.

Show Hours: Check-in Saturday from 7:30-8:30 am Judging begins promptly at 9:00 am both days. Official Show Hours are from 9 am-4 pm both days.

Entry Info: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to contact the Entry Clerk to confirm receipt of online or fax entries; the Entry Clerk or Club will not be responsible for entries lost due to communication errors. No substitutions accepted after the closing date. All championship, premiership and kitten entries with registration numbers or temporary registration numbers will be scored for CFA National and Regional points. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number. No refunds for failure to bench.

Transportation: Commercial transportation from the airport to the hotels is available as well as some of the hotels provide courtesy transportation. The club will be unable to provide other transportation.

Awards: All Championship, Premiership and Registered kittens will be scored for National and Regional awards. All show rules will be strictly enforced. Copies of the show rules are available for \$7 from CFA 260 East Main St. Alliance, OH 44601.

Household Pets: All Household Pets over the age of 8 (eight) months must be neutered or spayed and may not be declawed.

Health: This is a non-vetted show; all entries should be inoculated against Panleukopenia, Rhinotracheitis and the Calici Viruses, and we recommend that they be tested for FeLV prior to entering the show hall. All cats must be free of mites, fleas, fungus and any contagious illnesses. The show committee reserves the right to remove any cat or kitten from the show hall if suspected of having any of the above ailments until examined by a licensed veterinarian at the owner/agent's expense. Kittens under 4 months of age will not be permitted in the show hall. Proof of age may be requested. All claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching.

Supplies: Bring your own litter pans. Club will provide litter. Individual cage size is 22" X 22" X 22".

The ARK will be providing adult volunteers for stewards. The rescue work they do and the support given to the CFA and our club is greatly appreciated by our club and the community. Part of our proceeds goes to the ARK so they can continue their rescue work in our community.
