Entries: Entries must be typed or printed legibly, signed and submitted on an official CFA entry form. On-line entry will be available via <catshows.us>. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to confirm receipt of entries. Club is not responsible for on-line and faxed entries not received due to communication errors. Paid entries will be entered before on-line and fax entries.

Payments and fees: E-mail and faxed entries will be accepted at no additional charge if paid before the day of the show. **Entries paid at the door must be in cash.** A \$35 check fee will be charged on all returned checks. No refunds for failure to bench. Please make checks payable to **Southern Dixie Cat Club**. Sorry, NO PAYPAL accepted.

Show Hall: Richmond Raceway Complex, Colonial Bldg., 600 East Laburnum Avenue, Richmond, VA 23222. The Show Hall is both heated and air-conditioned. This is a Non-Smoking facility. Parking is free for exhibitors and spectators. Raceway phone number is 804-228-7506.

Supplies: Clay litter will be provided. Please bring your own litter pans, cat food, and water/food dishes.

Health: This is a non-vetted show. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. Exhibitors in violation will be told to leave the show hall.

Use of security cage with a single entry will require the purchase of an extra ½ cage.

Free ½ cage with 5 or 7 entries.

General: CFA Show rules will be strictly enforced. Copy of rules may be found at www.cfa.org/Publications/CFAManuals.aspx. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition. All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with an Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number (TRN). Kittens may be entered without registration numbers, but will not be scored for CFA awards if a number is not provided at show time. Kittens without a registration number or TRN will not be included in the count. It is the Exhibitors responsibility to check entry confirmation and notify entry clerk of any errors.

Benching: All benching will be by exhibitor and no changes in assignment will be allowed without permission of the Show Manager. Cages are 22"W x 22"H x 22"D. Benching request made at the time of entry will be honored whenever possible. No refunds for failure to bench.

People food: There will be no food available at the show hall. Judging will stop for 30 minutes to allow you to go out to nearby food places. Your own food/coolers are welcome.

This is the 2nd show of a 6x6 weekend held in conjunction with the Dixieland Silver & Golden Fanciers. Best in show Silver/Golden Persian awards will be presented Sunday afternoon after the completion of judging in all 12 rings.
