General: This is a CFA licensed show and all show rules will be enforced. A copy of the current show rules can be obtained online at www.cfa.org or by sending \$7 to: CFA, Inc 260 East Main St, Alliance, OH 44601

Show Hall: Jacob Building, Chilhowee Park, 339 Lakeside Street, Knoxville, TN. Show hall is handicap accessible, has heat and air conditioning. People food is available on-site.

Entry Information: All entries must be submitted on an official CFA entry blank or online. All entry fees must accompany entries, online entries must be paid within 10 days or at check-in, whichever comes first. It is the exhibitors responsibility to confirm receipt of faxed/online entries; the club will not be responsible for lost entries due to communication errors. Make checks payable to Tennessee Valley Cat Fanciers, Inc. (TVCF, Inc), Returned Check fee \$50.

Show Hours: Check-in is from 730am until 8:30am. Judging begins promptly at 9am both Saturday and Sunday. Show hours 9am to 5pm Saturday, and 9am to 4pm Sunday. Advertised hours are 10a-5p Saturday and 9a-4p Sunday.



Supplies and Miscellaneous: Cages are approximately 22" x 22" x 22". Litter will be provided, but bring your own litter pans, food dishes, and cat food. Novice exhibitors, bring cage curtains and grooming aids. Please bring cats in suitable carriers.

Show Hotel: There are several pet friendly hotels nearby (Red Roof & LaQuinta to North, East & West, and more).

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number. Kittens may be entered without registration numbers, but will not be scored for CFA awards if a number is not provided at show time. Kittens without a registration number or TRN will not be included in the count. Show Rule 2.19E The MISCELLANEOUS (Non-competitive) CLASS is for any registered cat or registered kitten of a breed not accepted for Provisional Breed competition. Miscellaneous Class entries are examined by judges; however, no awards will be made in this class. All Bengal championship, premiership and kitten entries can enter under a TRN, but all Bengals in the show hall must be registerable, (5 generation pedigree with no wild blood).

Non-vetted Show: All cats should be free of fleas, fungus, mites, and contagious diseases. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition. No kittens below 4 months of age allowed in show hall.

Fly Ins: Knoxville's McGhee Tyson Airport is about 25 minutes from the show hall. Apologizes, as we are not able to offer pick-up & drop off for exhibitors.
