**Entry Info:** All entries must be submitted on an official CFA entry form, printed or typed clearly. On-line entry available at [www.cfamidwest.org](http://www.cfamidwest.org). All checks must be drawn on US banks and in US funds. Please make checks payable to Lincoln State Cat Club. Lincoln State Cat Club does accept Square payments, PayPal payments (DO NOT USE FRIENDS AND FAMILY AS THE PAYMENT OPTION, THE PAYMENT WILL BE REFUSED) the information will be provided in your confirmation. Payment is expected prior to the open of the show. No payments accepted at the door.

Per show rules, all entries must be paid whether in attendance or not. No refunds for failure to bench. Only one benching request can be honored.

**REMINDER:** If you are using the online entry: It is each exhibitor's responsibility to email the entry clerk to be sure all your entries have been received! If you do not email the entry clerk, and receive a reply, there is no guarantee that your entries have been received! Please try to give our entry clerk a minimum of 24 hours to reply.

Check-in between 7:30 and 8:30 AM Saturday. Judging will begin at 9:00 am

There will be no food vendor on the premises. Pop machines, YES. We are having lunch brought in. All freshly made from a local business in town. Delivered fresh to our door at the time of lunch. You have a choice of a roast beef with cheddar, turkey with cheddar, ham with cheddar, chicken salad or a veggie sandwich on a freshly baked soft Kaiser roll with lettuce and tomato, classic ruffle potato chips, fruit salad and a beverage. Dessert will be a bakery fresh lemon and raspberry filled cake, with buttercream topping that is just going to be out of this world! You are also more than welcome to bring in food/beverage. The cost of this incredible lunch is only \$9.00, and you add that onto your entry fee and pay beforehand. No modifications to lunch if purchased.

There is no official show hotel. The La Quinta inn Madison, and the Baymont Inn Janesville are both cat friendly suggestion hotels with breakfast.

Exhibitors can set up their benching on Friday evening between 5-6 pm.

This is a non-vetted show. Cats are expected to be free of fungus, fleas and infectious disease "It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have all claws (front & back) clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition."

Cats are not allowed to remain in the show hall overnight. No smoking permitted in benching areas. Litter will be provided, please bring your own litter pans. Cage sizes are 22"x22"x22". Lincoln State Cat Club and Jefferson Fair Park will take reasonable care to safeguard the property of exhibitors and vendors. Neither the club, its members nor the Jefferson Fair Park will be liable for any loss or damage. All cats must be removed from the show hall at the close of the show Saturday night. The show hall is handicapped accessible and is equipped with both heat and air conditioning. Food will be available.

**CFA Info:** "All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number." This show is licensed by The Cat Fanciers Association, Inc. All CFA rules will be strictly enforced.
